 - Visit to production facility







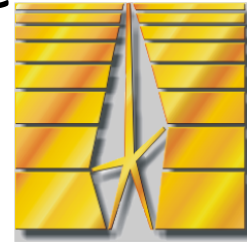
Tuesday April 26

 - Adjacent to Catherine palace





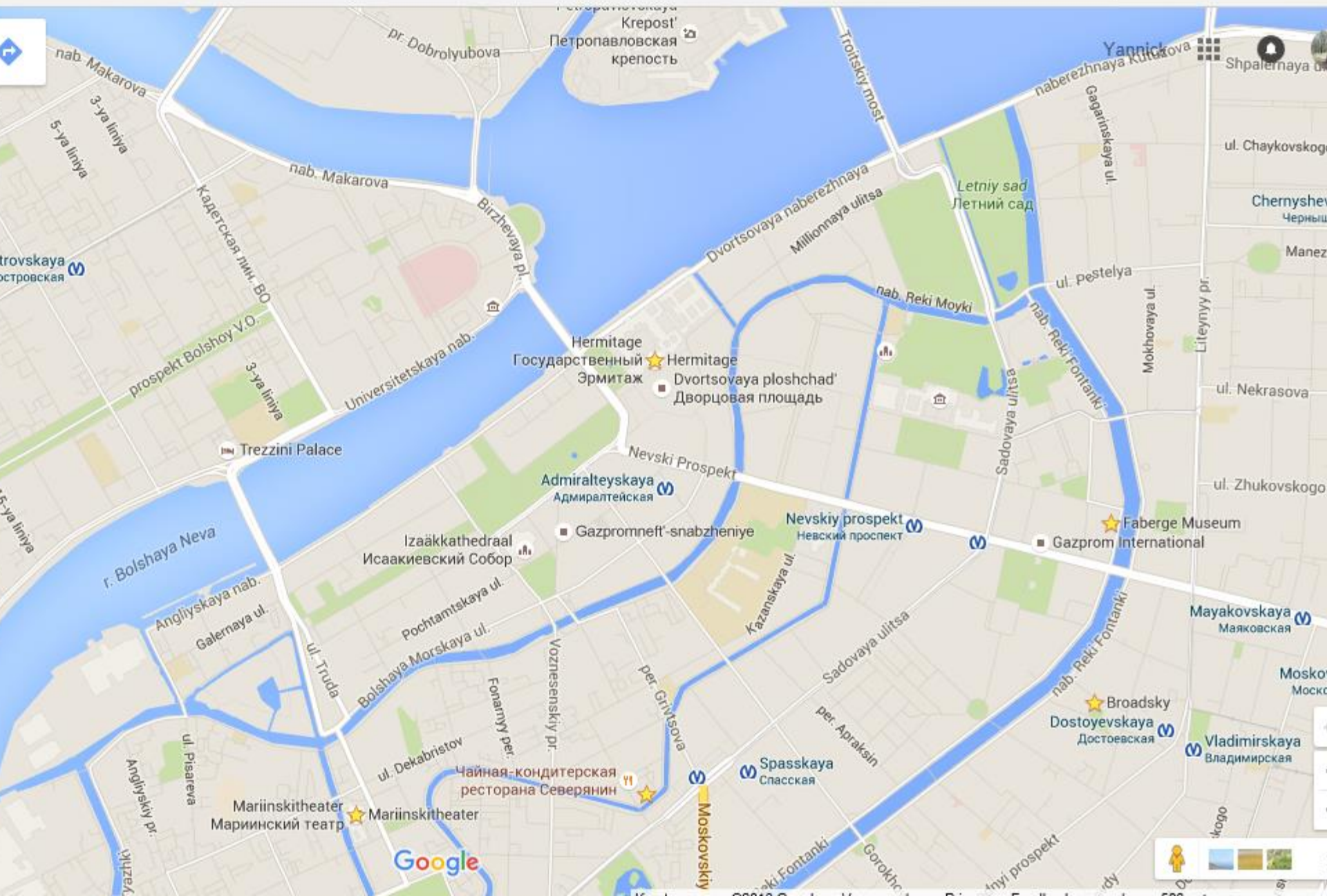




Thursday April 28

- Take in the sun at Summer Garden, Alexander Garden or the Mikhailovsky Gardens
- Yusupov palace (next to Mariinsky theatre)
